



COVID-19 Honor Code for the 2020-2021 School Year

The John Carroll School COVID-19 Honor Code is an agreement among all members of our school community designed to create a healthy environment where personal and community responsibility are prioritized and valued.

To that end, as a member of The John Carroll School Community, I pledge to:

- Use SchoolDoc to submit an honest daily temperature reading and self-screening for COVID-like symptoms
- Stay home from school and after-school activities if I have COVID-19 symptoms, and notify the school nurse of the reason for my absence
- Remain at home in quarantine if you have been identified as a close contact of someone who tested positive for COVID-19, is symptomatic and awaiting a COVID-19 test result, or if you are awaiting your own test result
- Cooperate with contact tracing efforts
- Wear a face covering when in classrooms and other common spaces
- Maintain a physical distance of 6 feet while on campus
- Wash my hands often with soap and warm water for at least 20 seconds; if soap and water are not available, then I will use an alcohol-based hand gel with at least 60% alcohol
- Not share food, beverages, utensils, water bottles, cell phones, or laptops with others
- Be mindful that my behaviors while off-campus can impact the entire John Carroll community by placing others at risk if I should contract /covid-19 and spread it to vulnerable people
- Take extra precautions when out of school by avoiding large group events and continuing safety measures
- Follow Maryland guidelines with regard to travel
