The John Carroll School Math Department Frequently Asked Questions

What Math Class do freshmen take at John Carroll?

All students take some form of Algebra in 9th grade. Students are placed in Algebra I unless they have taken Algebra I in middle school and are either exempt from taking the Algebra placement test or earn a high enough score on the Algebra placement test to be placed into Algebra 2.

If my child was not exempt from taking the Algebra placement test, does that mean that they cannot take Algebra 2?

No. It just means that they would need to come in and take the Algebra placement test. If they earn the required score and they have taken Algebra 1 in Middle School, they will be placed in Algebra 2.

What is the difference between Honors Algebra 2 and Advanced Algebra 2?

They are both considered "Honors" level classes. Honors Algebra 2 is the highest level and goes at a slightly faster pace, with problems at a slightly higher level of difficulty.

When is the Algebra placement test offered this year?

It is being offered March 10, 2020; March 11, 2020; and March 12, 2020.

How long is the Algebra Placement test?

It is typically about 1 hour although students can leave when they are finished.

Do I have to sign up for the Algebra Placement Test?

No. Your child just has to come on one of the three dates listed above.

Does my child have to take the Algebra Placement test?

No. Your child should take it only if they wish to take an Algebra 2 class and did not receive an exemption letter in their acceptance packet.

What is the Geometry Exemption Exam?

This is an exam for students who have taken a full year long Geometry class in Middle School and wish to not take Geometry here at John Carroll. Students in 10th grade typically take Geometry.

Do I have to sign up or the Geometry Exemption Exam.?

When is the Geometry Exemption Exam?

April 30, 2020

Does my child have to take the Geometry Exemption Exam?

No. They should take it only if they had a full year of Geometry in middle school and do not wish to take Geometry in 10th grade.

What AP courses do you offer in Math?

We offer AP Calculus AB, AP Calculus BC, and AP Statistics.

What classes will my child take in their Senior Year?

Depending upon their interest and ability It could be, Algebra 2, Algebra 3 (College Algebra), Honors Calculus, Probability and Statistics, or one of the three AP courses we offer.
