

Frequently Asked Questions from Incoming Parents

Lockers

- Will my student be assigned a locker?
 - Each student will be assigned a locker located near their Advisory. The Advisor will give them their locker assignment and combination at New Student Orientation and students will have a chance to practice opening their locker on that day. Returning students will receive locker assignments on the first day of school.
- What if my student forgets their locker combination or has difficulty getting it open?
 - Advisors and administration have the locker combinations and will be available to assist students who forget their combination or have difficulty opening lockers.

Attendance

- How do I let the school know if my student will be absent, late or needs to leave early?
 - If a student is absent, late, or requires an early dismissal from school, a
 parent/guardian should e-mail attendance@johncarroll.org before 8:30 a.m. on
 the day of the event. E-mail communications with regard to attendance will be
 accepted only when received from a parent/legal guardian e-mail account that
 the School has on record. All communication from the parent/guardian should
 include the student's first and last name, current grade level, date(s) of
 absence(s)/lateness/early dismissal and reason for absence(s)/lateness/early
 dismissal.

School Hours and Schedule

- How early can my student arrive and how late can they stay?
 - The building is open as early as 7:00 a.m. Students are welcome in the main hallway and the Patriot Café starting at that time. The building closes when the last group or team is finished for the day. Security is present on campus from 6:30 a.m. – 7:30 p.m., Monday-Friday.
- What time do athletic practices start?
 - While the school day ends at 2:45 p.m., practices start at 3:30 p.m. On D days, the school day ends at 2:15 p.m. and practices start at 3:00 p.m.

Patriot Café & Food Service

- When does the Patriot Café serve food?
 - The café serves breakfast, lunch and after school snack.
- What are my payment options?
 - The café accepts cash or students can pay using a John Caroll HarCo debit card.

Dress Code

- Is there a gym uniform?
 - There is no gym uniform. Student are permitted to wear their own shorts and tshirt, as long as they comply with the dress code.

- When does winter dress code begin?
 - Winter dress code begins November 1 and ends the first Monday after Spring Break.

 - There is no formal supply list, but if teachers have any specific requests for the classes, they will let students know during the first week.

 - Yes, you can purchase select items via the online store.

Extracurriculars

- How can my student get involved with extracurricuar activities?
 - **Athletics** Students can register to try out for the sport of their choice through their <u>SchoolDoc account</u>. Simply click Registration once logged in.

- My student signed up to be a Shadow Host. What does that mean?
 - As we welcome prospective Patriots onto campus, we pair them witha current student with similar interests to 'shadow.' The prospective student will go to classes with their host, eat lunch with their host and the admissions team and be a resource to answer any questions the prospective student may have. Hosts will not have a shadow every day, but can expect to have one every few weeks. If your student has a shadow, they will be contacted 48 hours in advance.

 - You will receive a link to pre-order your class shirt at the beginning of the school year from your class moderator.

 - Each grade is assigned a class moderator to coordinate service projects, social activities and special events.
