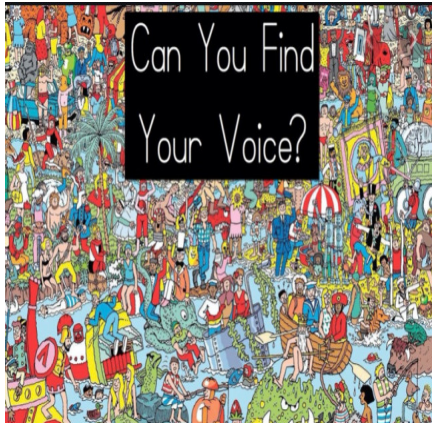


# Reliable Sources for Gathering Information
